STAPHYLO LA "SEIKEN" POSITIVE CONTROL

This control contains inactivated, lyophilized Staphylococcus aureus cells.

INTENDED USE

To confirm positive test results when using STAPHYLO LA "SEIKEN."

METHOD OF USE

- 1. Add 0.5 mL saline to the vial and suspend well.
- 2. Place one drop of this suspension on the agglutination plate.
- 3. Add one drop of the sensitized latex reagent to the suspension.
- 4. Mix well with the stirrer and shake the plate manually back and forth for 20 seconds while observing the progress of the agglutination.
- 5. Interpret immediately by visual inspection under sufficient light.
- 6. Refer to STAPHYLO LA "SEIKEN" instruction sheet for the details.

PRECAUTIONS

- 1. Store reconstituted suspension at -20 $^{\circ}\text{C}$. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
- Although the S. aureus cells contained in this reagent have been inactivated, they should be treated as living cells and handled with appropriate precautions.
